### **USDA RADIO NEWS (Weekday mornings at 5, 6, 7, and 8 am)**

Each weekday morning following Feature Story News, Radio Cobleskill features brief radio news reports from the United States Department of Agriculture for our region’s farmers.

### **ON THE FARM RADIO (Monday through Friday 5:30 am, Saturday 5 am)**

Established in 2002, On The Farm Radio is a daily farm news broadcast focused on the eastern United States, including the Mid-Atlantic region, the Northeast and the Southeast. On The Farm Radio strives to meet the needs of the farming community, covering agriculture from top to bottom! Presented by Jeff Ishee and Jesse Martin.

### **A MOMENT IN TIME (Monday through Friday, 8:30 am)**

Two-minute weekday module on history providing background on current events and important historical events and persons, explaining their significance. Some segments include historic audio. Hosted by Dan Roberts.

### **PROFILE AMERICA (Monday through Friday 9:30 am, Saturday and Sunday 5 pm)**

Profile America’s audio features are daily 60-second vignettes from key events, observances or commemorations for that day to highlight information collected by the U.S. Census Bureau.

### **THE DAILY CONSUMER RADIO REPORT (Monday through Friday, 11:30 am)**

A one-minute daily update on consumer news, brought to you by ConsumerAffairs.

### **ON THE MONEY MINUTES (Monday through Friday, 12:30 pm)**

One minute daily financial tips and advice from Certified Financial Planner Steve Pomeranz.

### **THE LOH DOWN ON SCIENCE (Monday through Friday, 3:30 pm)**

The Loh Down on Science is the fun way to get your daily dose of science in less than two minutes. The program explains the world of science with a dash of humor. Hosted by writer/performer and Caltech alumna Sandra Tsing Loh, it's a program for those who love science as well as for those who avoid it!

### **A MOMENT OF SCIENCE (Monday through Friday, 4:30 pm)**

A Moment of Science is a daily audio podcast, public radio program and video series providing the scientific story behind some of life's most perplexing mysteries.

### **SOUND BEAT (Monday through Friday, 5:30 pm)**

Got 90 seconds? Then you've got time for a trip through the history of recorded sound! Sound Beat is a daily, 90 second show highlighting the holdings of the Belfer Audio Archive. The Belfer is part of the Syracuse University Libraries, and is one of the largest sound archives in the United States. Each SB episode focuses on one particular recording from the Archive, and provides a back story detailing its place in recording history.

### **CURRENTCAST (Monday through Friday, 6:30 pm)**

Water issues affect everyone in the Great Lakes and surrounding watersheds, including environmentalists, outdoor enthusiasts, boaters, beach-goers, clean water activists, swimmers, fishermen—and you! To connect you to news and solutions, CurrentCast is a brief radio segment which highlights the importance of water stewardship and sustainability in the Great Lakes and surrounding watersheds.

### **THE 80s AT 8 (Daily, 8 pm)**

Each evening at 8 pm, Radio Cobleskill presents a musical journey back in time to the 1980s, with a full hour of non-stop 80s music, from the biggest hits of the decade to forgotten classics.

### **THE 90s AT 9 (Daily, 9 pm)**

Each evening at 9 pm, Radio Cobleskill's musical journey continues with a trip back to the 1990s, featuring a full-hour of non-stop hits and forgotten classics from this decade.

### **LAKE AIR (Monday, 6 am)**

From the Finger Lakes region of upstate New York comes Lake Air. The program derives its name from that of a radio station in the area whose call letters were WLKA. Produced at KCRW in Los Angeles.

### **SING OUT! RADIO MAGAZINE (Monday, 10 pm)**

The Sing Out! Radio Magazine is a weekly, hour-long “magazine format” program, hosted by Tom Druckenmiller, featuring interviews in addition to “live” and recorded music and spotlighting the cultural diversity and heritage of all traditional and contemporary folk musics.

### **DESTINIES – THE VOICE OF SCIENCE FICTION (Monday, 11 pm)**

Hundreds of writers, artists, editors, actors, producers, directors, and musicians have appeared on the program since its debut in April, 1983. Regular features include: the Destinies Audiobook Sampler, Soundtrack Spotlight, Graphic Detail, the Destinies Radio Theater, Christopher DeFilippis’ “DeFlip Side,” convention updates and highlights, as well as host Dr. Howard Margolin’s flawless interviews. ### **IMP INDIE BLUES (Saturday, 1 pm)**

IMP Indie Blues with DJ Suzy is a one hour broadcast that is jammed packed with some of the best Blues Music by Independent Blues Musicians around the globe. If you are a Blues fan don't miss this brilliant mix! Produced by Independent Musicians Promotions.

### **IMP INDIE COUNTRY (Saturday, 2 pm)**

If you want to hear good Country Music from some of the best Independent Artists from all over the world, this is the place to be! IMP Indie Country offers an hour of the newest and best Indie Country Music anywhere! Produced by Independent Musicians Promotions.

### **RADIO SERENA (Saturday, 3 pm)**

Radio Serena is a weekly one hour syndicated music program unlike anything you've ever heard. Every week, Serena (The Radio Kid) offers up an eclectic mix of 90s hits, solid gold oldies, and whatever else somehow manages to make its way into the mix. The show also offers frequent specials, theme shows, and "the format of the month" where Serena presents her take on well known, and not so well known, radio formats. Radio Serena, "playing what a girl wants."

### **TRAVELERS IN THE NIGHT (Saturday and Sunday, 10 pm)**

Travelers In The Night is your unique source of insider information from the asteroid hunting and space communities. It features an engaging and informative series of two-minute factual episodes about asteroids, comets, spacecraft, and other objects in space. The Travelers In The Night Pieces are written and produced by an observing member of the Catalina Sky Survey Team at the University of Arizona and are hosted by Al Grauer.

### **TRANCE ON THE PORCH (Saturday, 10 pm)**

Featuring two hours of dance and electronic music each week, the content of each broadcast of Trance On The Porch is comprised of one new mix, recorded live by the show's host and producer, DJ Mark. The balance of each episode contains one guest mix set, either from a talented but relatively unknown DJ, or a classic mix set from one of the giants of the industry. Particular focus is paid to mixes that have stood the test of time and, despite their age, still remain fresh in the ears of other DJs and producers globally, but have largely been unheard by listeners in the United States. Although TOTP is, at its core, a club mix show, frequently, trance, progressive house, breaks, drum n bass, and electro house mixes are featured.

### **UPSTATE RADIO THEATRE (Sunday, 5 am)**

Do you remember when a cup of coffee was a nickel and a newspaper was a dime? Even if you don't, we invite you to join us each week for an hour of sounds from the Golden Age of Radio. You'll hear some of the best old time radio programs. Big names such as Jack Benny, The Lone Ranger, Suspense, Lux Radio Theater, and The Shadow. You'll also hear many forgotten classics and obscurities, as well as some more contemporary radio dramas such as The CBS Radio Mystery Theater, Alien Worlds, and Nightfall. Brought to you by Quality Radio Productions, hosted by Jake Longwell.

### **COUNTRY ROOTS (Sunday, 6 am)**

Old-time country and bluegrass music, showcasing songs and interviews rarely heard on the radio today. Hosted by Bruce Cutler and produced by Do It Right Productions.

### **DICK LEE AND 60s GARAGE ROCK FROM CALIFORNIA (Sunday, 7 am)**

Join Dick Lee from the 60's rock group – The Brymers – along with his partner in crime “The Iceman” to hear the mind blowing sounds of California garage rock during the decade of the 1960's, the national hits of the day, along with cool interviews from 60's rock musicians as they share their rock-n-roll memories.

### **THE MOP TOPS AND THE KING (Sunday, 8 am)**

Featuring the music of The Beatles and Elvis Presley with some fun surprises in between. This show aims to bring joy and happiness to the world through the music of The Beatles and Elvis, one listener at a time! Hosted by Steve Chelmsford.

### **ROCKIN' IN THE DAYS OF CONFUSION (Sunday, 9 am)**

A weekly 60-minute show that revisits the golden age of rock radio (roughly the years 1968-76). Emphasis is on longer album tracks from a variety of then-emerging rock sub-genres, including hard rock, folk-rock (both British and American), heavy metal, jazz-rock fusion, art-rock and more experimental tracks that defy easy classification. Hosted by “The Hermit.”

### **COFFEEHOUSE RADIO (Sunday, 10 am)**

It's all about music from singers and songwriters! Each week, CoffeehouseRadio broadcasts an hour long radio program with music from some of today's finest singers and songwriters. Many of the names of the artists will be familiar; but, some might be new to you and to your listeners. Hosted by Tom Wilson.

### **THE MANY MOODS OF BEN VAUGHN (Sunday, 11 am)**

Producer, composer, and recording artist Ben Vaughn is a man of many moods — and many hats. He produces and hosts The Many Moods of Ben Vaughn, a weekly, hour-long eclectic mix of music featuring rock, blues, jazz, folk, soul, rhythm and blues, country, bossa nova, movie soundtracks, easy listening and more, all peppered with his twisted musicological slant.

Produced by KCRW in Los Angeles.

### **AMERICAN VARIETY RADIO (Sunday, 12:30 pm)**

If you want a break from political talk, if all that ranting is wearing you out, then you'll feel right at home with American Variety: Radio for the rest of us! American Variety Radio features discussions on a wide variety of topics—in fact, anything but politics. Every week is a different theme, from interviews with amazing people who followed their dream and succeeded, to explorations of history, science, and technology, to in-depth looks at fascinating out-of-the-way subjects. Hosted by Court Lewis.

### **RADIO SURVIVOR (Sunday, 1 pm)**

Radio Survivor is a weekly show that explores the future of community media, with a focus on community radio, college radio, low-power FM and public access TV, along with podcasting and internet radio.
